It has a polished, silky, medium to full-bodied profile to go with impressive creme de cassis, spring flowers, and graphite aromas and flavors. While it's not a heavyweight, it has fabulous purity, balance and length, all suggesting it will evolve nicely for 10-15 years.

Tobacco leaf over black cherries and plums. It's a savory wine, vinous, vibrant and supple, marked by fine, thrillingly sensuous tannins. As sexy a wine as Jean-François Pellet has ever made.

Outstanding!

It's a fruit basket of berries in the nose, joined by chocolate-covered marshmallow and cherry jay. On the pour, there's more of the same as black cherry, black currant and Marionberry swirl amid a smooth and creamy texture with pleasant finish of age-worthy tannins.
