### 92 points

Smooth and lush with lovely structure, bright fruit, lovely balance and complexity; subtle, supple and bursting with spice, excellent depth; long and charming. Named for the three partner families: Pellet, McKibben and Goff. (*The Tasting Panel, October 2011*)



### 91 points

A new blend for Pepper Bridge, Trine is named for the three main partners and includes all five Bordeaux red grapes. Tannic and earthy, with a powerful core of dark fruit, this needs more bottle time to fully integrate. Layers of fruit are mixed with loam, iron, licorice and espresso, full-bodied and deep. P.G.
