2015 Walla Walla Valley Trine Trine in 2015 leads with cabernet franc, the balance cabernet sauvignon, merlot, malbec and petit verdot, from four vineyards, three of which, Seven Hills, Pepper Bridge and Octave, are estate owned. It has a red-fruit core and a generous, suede-like texture, delivering firm, windswept grippiness in the end, with fine graphite tannins and the basalt-laden feel of minerality. Gorgeous now, this will reward those who cellar it. *Reviewed by Patrick J. Comiskey.*
